



# CALL FOR ABSTRACTS

## JOINT ANNUAL MEETING 2022

### SAPPM & SPS

The Swiss Society of Pain (SPS) and the Swiss Academy for Psychosomatic and Psychosocial Medicine (SAPPM) invite members and other colleagues to submit abstracts to be considered for poster presentation at the annual meeting of the SPS & SAPPM, taking place on November, 10th – 11th 2022 at the Eventfabrik Bern.

Works presented at previous congresses during the past years will be accepted.  
Recycle your posters from conferences of the last year; e.g. IASP, CARL, ECU or WFC!

A poster presentation will take place during the congress and the winner of the poster prizes will be chosen amongst presenters.

Please find below instructions for preparation of abstracts.

#### A. TOPICS

Posters will be accepted on a wide array of topics related in some way to pain, musculoskeletal health and manual treatment approaches.

#### B. GENERAL POLICIES

- SPS: Abstracts should be submitted in English before August 15th, 2022.
- SAPPM: Abstracts can be submitted in German, English, Italian or French before August 15th, 2022.
- Notifications of acceptance will be sent to presenting authors by the end of September 2022.
- Scheduling details and instructions for poster presentations will be included within this correspondence.
- Authors whose abstract is accepted must register for the congress.
- Submissions not conforming to established guidelines will not be reviewed.

## D. ABSTRACT FORMAT

- Abstracts should be organized into the following sections: Aims, Methods, Results, and Conclusions.
- Acknowledgments should include grant support (including grant number) and disclosure of any financial relationship the author(s) may have with the manufacturer/supplier of any commercial products or services related to the work reported in the abstract.
- Text must have maximum 2500 characters incl. spaces.
- Please avoid tables, graphs and other types of images in abstract.
- Use standard abbreviations. Place special or unusual abbreviations in parentheses after the full term the first time it appears.
- Proofread carefully before submitting. Abstracts will not be edited.
